PLACE: CANAAN RECYCLING CENTER – 376 Hartland Road
(2 miles on Route 23 - North)

ONLY CANAAN RESIDENTIAL HOUSEHOLDS can drop off waste items!

WHAT WE CAN TAKE AT THIS WEEKEND!

BULKY WASTE – Household residential items that do not fit into a standard trash barrel.

METAL WASTE – Large items such as appliances (Refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners please leave compressor Freon gas intact). Any metal items and home outdoor equipment. ALL ENGINES & TANKS MUST BE DRAINED OF FLUIDS, including oil and gasoline. LATEX ONLY PAINT CANS MUST BE EMPTY & DRY. Propane gas containers must have fittings removed, or a hole drilled in them exposing the interior. It is helpful to separate the metal materials from the plastic or wood. NO ENTIRE CAR BODIES.

PAINT & WALL COVERING WASTE – NON-water based paint type **liquid materials NOT ACCEPTED** at this collection **BUT** liquid cans can be taken to Quinn's Hardware or Sherwin/Williams in Skowhegan in their **original container with label** for free disposal.

ELECTRONIC WASTE – TVs (tubes & flat-screens), computer monitors (CRTs), and computer towers, cell phones and computer accessories. **State law requires residential households must recycle TVs and computer monitors. This weekend is the time to do this!**

TIRES – Up to and including 16 inch sizes. Anything larger must be cut into 24-inch chunks. NO TIRES ON RIMS. NO OFF-ROAD, NO farm sized tractor tires. **LIMIT of 12 tires per household.**

UNIVERSAL (TOXIC) WASTE – (MUST BE INTACT) Auto acid batteries, small engine liquids, acid batteries, fluorescent light tubes (no incandescent bulbs), compact curly fluorescent bulbs, fluorescent light ballasts, rechargeable batteries, mercury thermometers, mercury switches or anything with liquid mercury in it that is intact!

NO OTHER HAZARDOUS LIQUID WASTE OR OILY FLUID WASTE WILL BE ACCEPTED.

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS LIQUIDS WILL BE COLLECTED @ THE EVENT ON OCTOBER 5th, 2019.

HOUSEHOLD DEMOLITION DEBRIS & WOOD WASTE – We will accept a **half** pickup load of home remodeling demolition waste, wood waste and brush.

LIMITS – Two (2) pickup loads of waste and 12 tires per household. Try to keep similar waste items separated to assist in distribution at transfer site. Please **do not** drop off items **before or after** the weekend in order to keep the transfer site clean. Thank you.

The next bulky waste drop-off weekend will be April 25 & 26, 2020

The next Household Hazardous Materials Collection Event will be October 5th, 2019 . More info at town office in September.
